Annual benefit changes for Medicare Advantage plan members under Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield will be effective January 1, 2025.

- Select PPO plans offer a combined monthly spending allowance on a benefits prepaid card; members have the flexibility to choose how to spend their allowance on the following benefits: assistive devices, utilities, groceries, and over-the-counter items
